I have included some instruction in the introduction and presented the ceremony in transliteration and translation, although I recommend that it be done using the transliteration if you do not know the Arabic, the translation is mainly provided for English speakers, in order to help set the attunement.

I wish to thank Pir Zia Inayat Khan for his ever present guidance and support for me and my work. He is always in my heart and the service my hands perform. I also wish to thank Pir Rasheed-ul-Hassan Jeeli-ul-Kaleemi of Hyderabad, India who has become an inspiration and light in my life. And Imam Bilal Hyde, who turned me to the straight path. And a special note of thanks to my wife, Tara Inayat Chishti, whose love has brought me through trials and tribulations and whose companionship on the path I value beyond all measure.

## Introduction

A Fatiha is a ceremony marking and celebrating an anniversary of a special event in the life of a person. Usually this is done to honor the Urs (anniversary of death) of a beloved teacher in the Silsila of a Sufi order. It may also be performed on a special day of each month which has become traditional for a particular person.

The recitation in the ceremony consists of readings from the Qur'an, du'a (prayers), darood (a phrase expressing love and blessings for the prophet Muhammad (saw)<sup>i</sup> and a recitation of a silsila (the silsila of the one celebrating the Urs, in this case the Chishti Inayati silsila).

The Fatiha is traditionally performed in the latter part of the afternoon, before sunset (this would be between the Islamic prayer times of 'Asr and Maghrib). When computing the date for the ceremony, remember that the Islamic day begins at sunset, so, for example if the date of the anniversary you are commemorating occurs on the fifth day of the month, that day actually begins after sunset on the fourth.

## Preparation

To perform the Fatiha you will first need a space which is conducive to spiritual practices. This might be a room or part of a room in your house where you normally pray or do your practices. It might also be in a public space, such as a meditation hall, khanka, yoga center, prayer space or similar

facility. (Remember to ask permission of the managers if this is a public space.)

In the area you have chosen you can set a prayer carpet. If you do not have a prayer carpet, then any clean cloth large enough for you to kneel on will do. If nothing is available then the floor, whether carpeted or not will be fine, just make sure it is clean. You should face toward Qibla, which is the direction of Mecca.<sup>ii</sup>

At the front of the prayer carpet place a bowl of pure water, sweets, and incense. The sweets should be on a plate and the incense, burning (if this is allowed in your location), in an incense holder. Any sweets will do such as candy, sweet cakes, baked goods, dates, etc. Any type of incense is fine, but rose is always a good choice. Other choices are nag champa, sandalwood, bakhoor, and luban (frankincense).

Next prepare yourself by kneeling on the prayer carpet and setting your intention to perform the Chishti Fatiha in the memory of the person whose anniversary is being celebrated. Relax your mind, your body, breath, and begin the recitation.

- i In this document we will use the abbreviation “saw” to stand for “salallahu alayhi wa salaam,” which is said after mentioning the prophet Muhammad (saw) as a way of honoring him.
- ii There are several resources for determining the direction of Mecca at your location. One of the easiest online sources is the Islamic Finder. The URL for this web site is <http://www.islamicfinder.org>. Once there you can enter your location and it will calculate prayer times and the direction.
